This includes the numerous health risks associated with frequent, low level exposure to this odourless, invisible and toxic gas. For example potential increased risk of falls and signs of dementia. Knowing the sources, signs and symptoms, and being able to manage the risks, will help organisations support vulnerable people and will ensure employers meet their Duty of Care to staff and volunteers.
